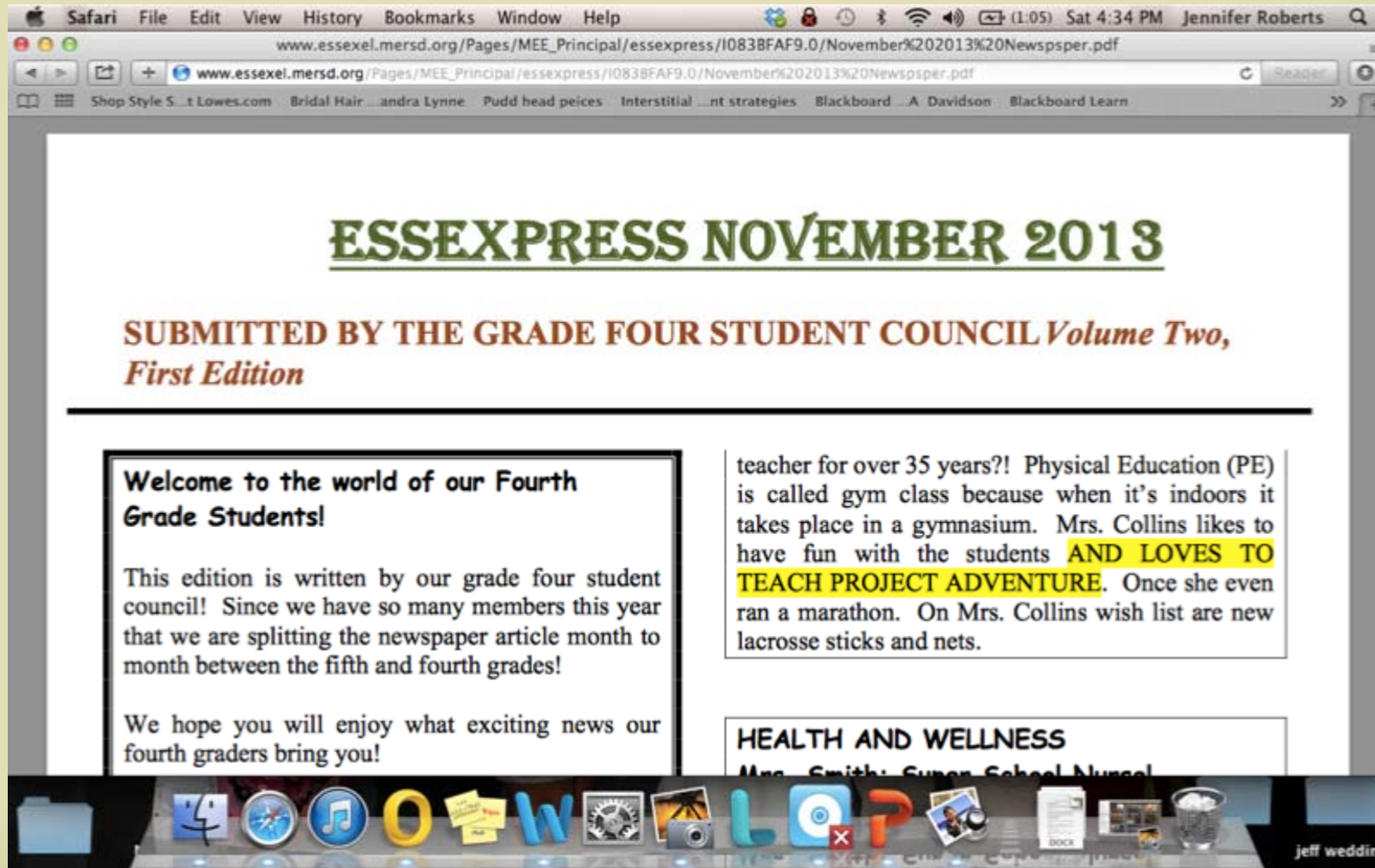

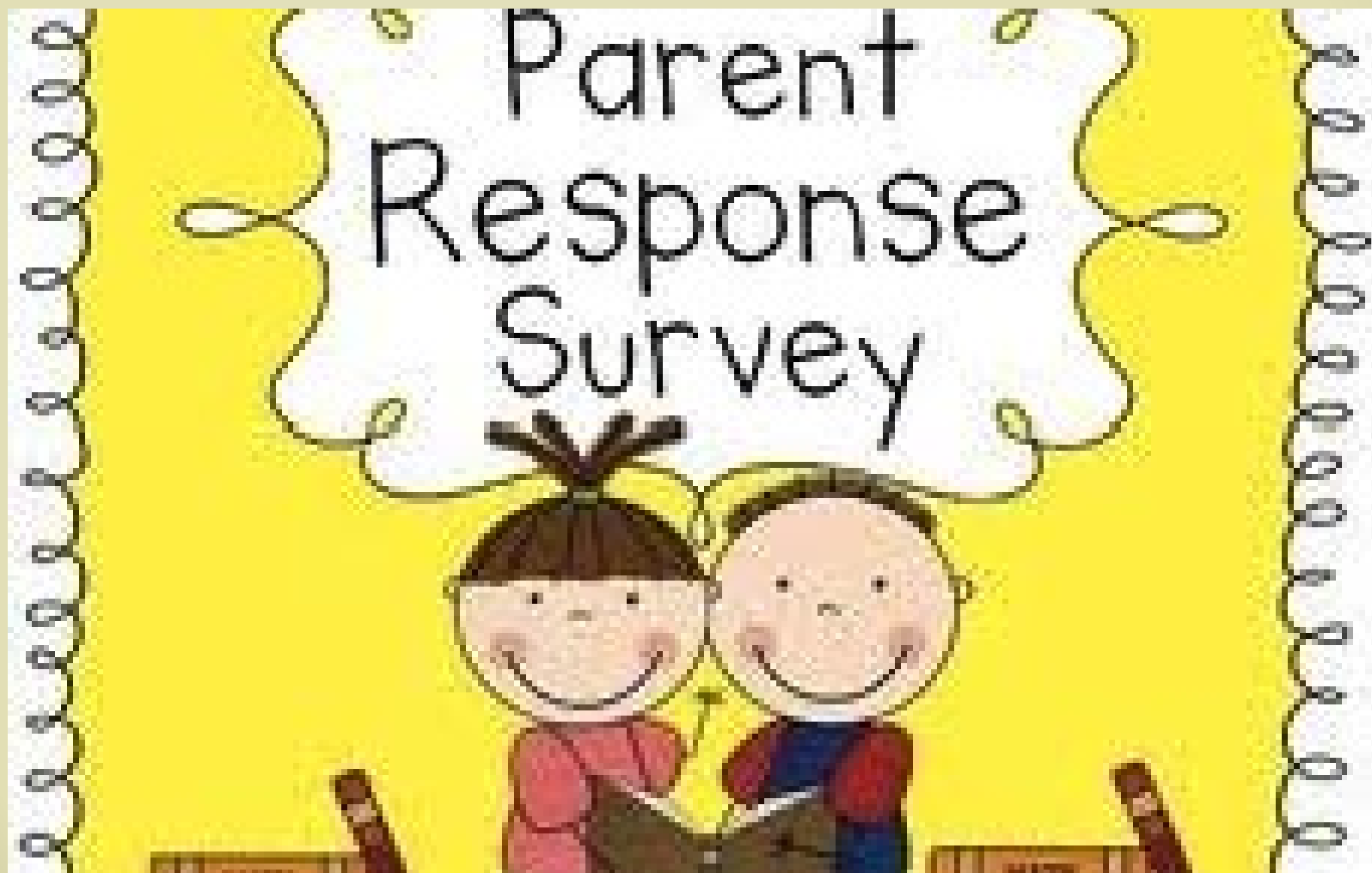



4th Grade at Lexington Symphony

On Thursday, the 4th graders visited the Lexington Symphony and learned about the orchestra through the ages. This musical journey began with the beginnings of formal music with a Gregorian chant. In King Arthur's time, they learned that the symphony was made up of recorders. From there, they heard Bach's famous Brandenburg concerto from the Baroque period. Ask your kids about the Surprise Symphony from Hadyn's time—that was unexpected! An 11 year old soloist gave inspiration during a violin concerto by Mozart. They saw the orchestra grow more and more as they heard Beethoven's 5th Symphony and then a piece by Tchaikovsky. The orchestra moved into the modern era with Rite of Spring by Stravinsky. But the highlight was the appearance of Darth Vader and hearing the beloved Star Wars theme by John Williams!

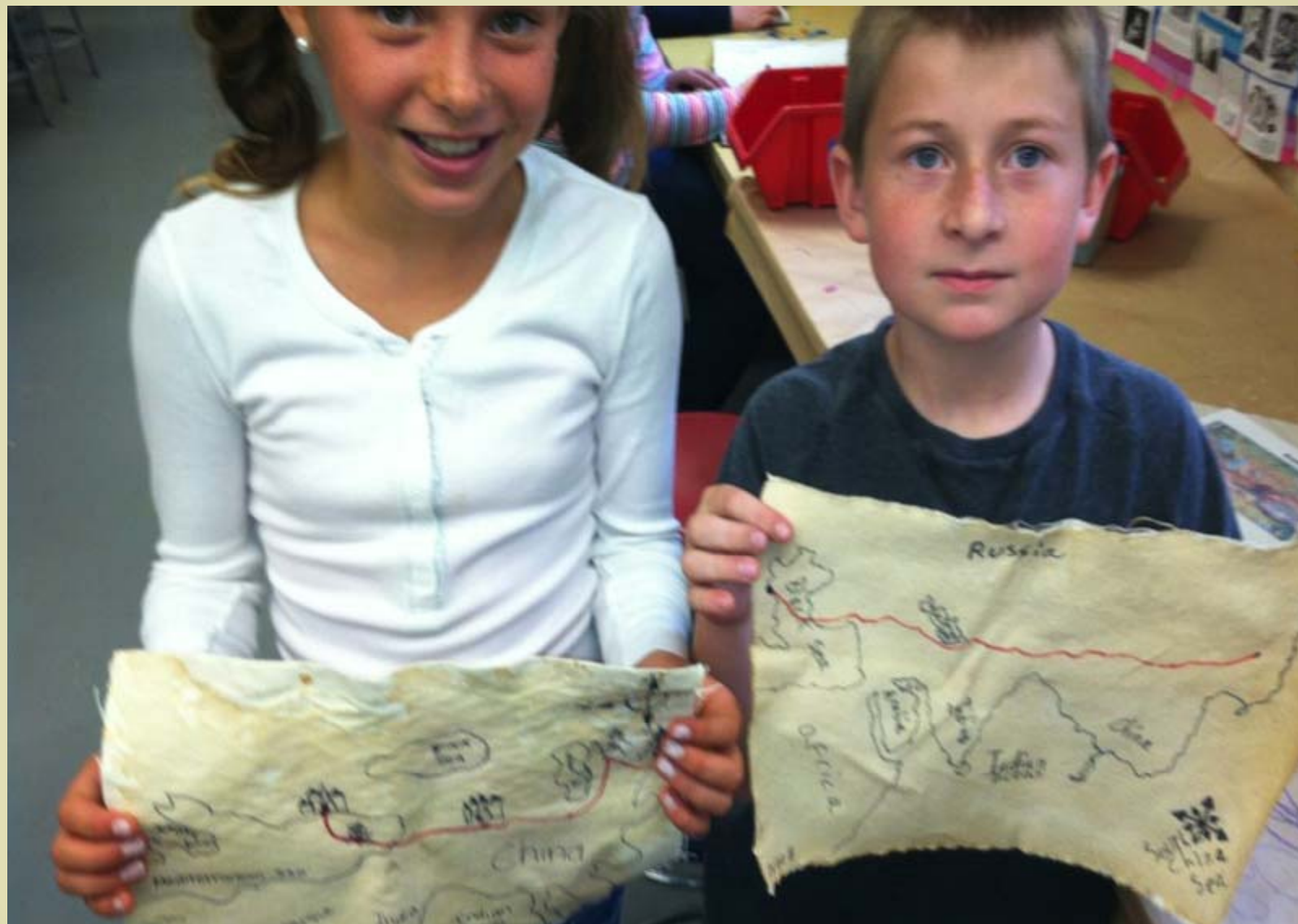
